

COMMON MISTAKES WHEN FILLING OUT THE FAFSA

- ✓ Leave the high school question blank.
 - *Here must be the name of the higher school of origin.*
- ✓ Incorrect Social Security number of parents and/or student.
 - *This information is extremely important for the Department of Education to verify your data to determine eligibility. To avoid mistakes, keep your Social Security card handy. Likewise, your name must be entered on the FAFSA Application exactly as it appears on the Social Security card.*
- ✓ Date of birth of the student or parents must be in month/day/year format.
 - *This is how the Department of Education verifies your date of birth. If the same is a single digit, always remember to add the number 0 before.*
- ✓ Selecting the academic degree incorrectly.
 - *The academic degree is the one you intend to study at ICPR Junior College. For example: Associate degree.*
- ✓ Address format.
 - *It is important that the address is correct as the Department of Education will be sending you important information about your eligibility.*
- ✓ Year in which you will be studying.
 - *At ICPR Junior College the associate degrees are up to two years.*
